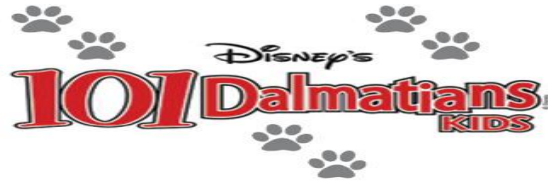

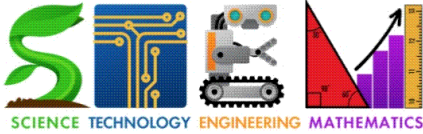

The fifth and sixth grade classes took a walking field trip to the Exeter River off of the Rockingham Recreational Trail and behind the Town Hall this past week. While there, students collected data on physical and chemical factors of the water in the river. This included the temperature, transparency, electrical conductivity, pH, and dissolved oxygen as well as sampling macroinvertebrate in the water body. The presence of lack of certain macroinvertebrate in a water body, in addition to the other factors listed, can help determine the overall health of a water body and lead to further investigations. It will be interesting to see what the students discover as the present drought has greatly impacted the water level in the river.
