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| Essential Question | <p>A thought provoking question designed to engage student in learning.</p> <p>Elem Ex: Why is it important to know and use people's name?</p> <p>MS Ex: What do good writers do to write a well-developed opinion essay?</p> |
| Content | <p>What information do we want student's to know?</p> <p>Elementary Ex: People's Names</p> <p>Middle School: opinion essay writing</p> |
| Skills | <p>What will the student's be able to do?</p> <p>Elementary: Associate people's names (notice Skill & Content may be similar)</p> <p>Middle School: differentiate between fact vs. opinion, write multiple drafts, understand the 6+1 traits of writing, elaborate on their writing, use transitional words effectively, write intriguing introductions, and understand the purpose of a concluding paragraph.</p> |
| Assessment | <p>To methodically assess student's learning.</p> <p>Elementary: Name Bingo</p> <p>Middle school: Completion of an essay, graded using the 6+1 Trait rubric.</p> |
