Dear Parents and Guardians of Fremont Students at Sanborn:

With the recent snow storms I would like to provide some clarity regarding what might take place when decisions are made to delay or cancel school in Fremont and Sanborn. Because road conditions may differ in Fremont, Kingston and Newton, there may be a difference in what decisions are made regarding school cancellations or delays.

If Fremont delays school and Sanborn does not, there will not be transportation to the high school until two hours later than normal. School will be in session at Sanborn at the regular time. Those Fremont students who arrive after the school day begins will not be counted as tardy. Unfortunately, they will miss class, but if it is determined that Fremont roads are not safe for buses, we cannot have them on the roads.

If Fremont cancels school and Sanborn does not, there will be no transportation to the high school and the Fremont students will not be counted as absent for the day.

If Sanborn delays school and Fremont does not, the earliest that Fremont high school buses can start their runs would be at 8:35AM, after the elementary run.

Whenever there is a difference between Fremont and Sanborn school status, every attempt will be made to keep you informed by the Alert Now system
